## **Rise of the Two Witnesses: Swear Falsely**

**2020**: The #20 can be spiritually understood as two 10's or 2x10. The year 2020 is two 20's, or 20-20. Symbolicallyspiritually, the **#2** means "**the fulness of testimony**." **#10** means **test**. There is no "testimony" without a "test." **2020** is starting the decade of the "fulness of testimony," meaning many things that the Voice of the Prophets have been proclaiming will start to manifest. These Anointed Ones have **fulfilled their obedience**, being tested and purified, found righteous by the blood of Christ. If you have the Holy Spirit in you, you have the potential for prophetic understanding. The "**Rise of the Two Witnesses**" is a paradigm of the Two Witnesses in the book of Revelation Chapter 11. These Two Witnesses prophesy with the fire of God and have tremendous authority. Our Sunday messages are prophetic proclamations, as we sound our "Trumpet Voice" to warn, assemble, equip, and celebrate with God's people.

The book of Zechariah is the most messianic of all Old Testament books. Zion is restored and radiates the glory of our Lord as the second temple is built. This gives us paradigms and prophecies of the second coming of Christ. Zech 5:1-7 is subtitled, "Vision of the Flying Scroll." In this prophetic vision, God sends out a flying scroll which is a curse or judgment to every **thief** and every **perjurer** (ones who **swear falsely** by God's name). The scroll is **20** cubits by **10** cubits and has writing on both sides. This scroll will enter their house and remain there until the house is consumed. To "perjurer" is to swear falsely, be a false witness, or **false testimony**. I believe the Lord said to me, "If those who **swear falsely** by My name, do not repent, their ministries will be consumed by My scroll, for it has been sent out," (<u>Isa 45:2</u>). This "Flying Scroll" is a type-shadow of the Scroll in <u>Rev. 5:1-7</u> which the Lion of the Tribe of Judah is about to open.

## Those who swear falsely by My name:

1. "Those who use My name for their personal gain, claiming to be Christian." There are many politicians, celebrities and other people in high-profile positions, claiming to be Christian to gain favor with people, but are wolves in sheep clothing. In <u>Mtt 7:15-23</u>, Jesus warns about this and tells us we will know them by their fruit. **Someone's fruit** is the result of their actions; what laws did they pass? What organizations do they support? Wolves will be exposed.

2. "Those who embrace sin, especially sexual immorality," (2 Tim 2:19, 1 Thes 4:3-7). Politicians are hell-bent on pushing the LGBTQ agenda, not because they care about people, but because they want to silence Christians and the Bible. Sexual immorality is a self-curse that can bring sickness and God's judgment (Rev 2:20-23, Num 25, 1 Cor 6:18). Churches will split and some will close. Christians who cling to sexual immorality will face self-imposed curses, but many will repent and be set free from sexual bondage.

#3-5 are Christians who **falsely testify** the gifts are dead, there is no Apostolic authority, expressive praise and worship is of the flesh, and all Pentecostal/Charismatics are of a "false doctrine." They not only express their doctrinal differences but **aggressively attack** and **testify against others**. When they see the coming glory of God filling the tabernacles and hear of the undeniable miracles, they will burn with remorse. They will not walk in the full authority of God. It is acceptable to disagree with another Christian doctrine, but to aggressively attack and testify against it, is dangerous. At what point do you become the Accuser? At what point are you testifying against the move of the Holy Spirit?

3. "Those who put a stumbling block on My altar of worship." These Christians testify against expressive worship and in doing so, testify against the book of Psalms which literally means "The Book of Praises." Psalms clearly describes expressive praise and worship filled with high energy; dancing, clapping, shouting, loud music, many types of instruments, raising hands, and standing as we **express** our love and gratitude (<u>141:2, 95:6, 134:1, 47:1, 149:3, 150:3-6</u>).

4. "Those who rebuke My delegated authority." Jesus gave us His delegated authority to equip the Saints. <u>Eph 4:11-12</u> And He Himself gave some to be **apostles**, some **prophets**, some **evangelists**, and some **pastors** and **teachers**, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.

5. "Those who declare My gifts are dead." God's gifts have not ceased manifesting through the Holy Spirit (<u>1 Cor 11:1-</u> <u>14</u>). Undeniable: Millions of Christians have operated in the gifts bringing glory to God and millions to God's saving grace. God's Apostolic authority, expressive worship and the gifts of the Holy spirit are self-evident and undeniable! Life Song Church: Living the Power of Praise!
