Righteous; #6662 *tsaddiyq* (tsad-deek) just and lawful. This is someone who responds to God's law out of love because it is written in his heart.

<u>Matt 6:33-34</u> But seek first the kingdom of God and His **righteousness**, and all these things shall be added to you. 34 Therefore **do not worry** about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

<u>Ps 37:25</u> I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the **righteous** forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread.

<u>Rom 1:16-17</u> For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. 17 For in it the **righteousness of God** is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The **just** (righteous) shall live by faith."
