## Fire of Righteous: Holy, Holy, Holy!

<u>Luke 12:49-52</u> "I came to **send fire on the earth**, and how I wish it were already kindled! 50 But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed (compelled) I am till it is accomplished! 51 Do you suppose that I came to give peace on earth? I tell you, not at all, but rather **division**. God's fire of righteousness causes division-separation. **Dan Bongino** expressed that no one is exempt from this battle in America and it is coming to everyone's door.

**Noah** and the flood, the Tower of Babel (gate of the god) Nimrod (let us rebel), the **Patriarch Abraham**; "your descendants shall **possess the gate** of your enemies." Abraham was 5 generations after Babel.

Unashamed-expressive praise and worship controls the gates and releases the fire of God. The Power of Praise and Worship: Kingdom Dynamics SFLB; (Pg 14 LSC Prayer book).

Ps 104:4 Who makes His angels spirits, His ministers a flame of fire.

<u>Heb 1:7</u> And of the angels He says: "Who makes His angels spirits And His ministers a flame of fire."

Ministers: #3011 Greek, leitougos (lie-toorg-oss) from loas "people" and ergon "work"; hence, working for the people. There are angels that are a flame of fire that work for the people (believers).

We have been given by Jesus, the authority on this earth, not the angels. We bring the authority through the name of Jesus (Word of God) they bring the fire power! We release the authority; the Word of God and the angels bring it to pass.

<u>Luke 10:17-20</u> ...Behold, **I give you the authority** to trample on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy**, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. <u>Rev 2:26-28</u> And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him **I will give power** (authority) over the nations -27 'He shall rule them with a rod of iron;

## The Power of Praise and Powerful Angels

<u>Isa 6:1-3</u> ...3 And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!" This is showing God's glory and authority.

**Holy:** SFLB Foot Notes; "The Hebrew word for holy means "**separated**" and "**unapproachable**," but we can approach because of the Lord of Hosts: a title for Yahweh. It signifies He is the **Deliverer** surrounded by hosts of heavenly power. Glory is that aspect of God's character that emphasizes His greatness and authority."

**Holy**: #6918 Hebrew *qadosh* (kah-dosh); Set apart for sacred purposes. Holiness is **separation** from everything profane or defiling.

**Seraphim**: #8313 Hebrew, "A burning fiery, gliding, angelic being." The root is the verb *seraph* "to set on fire; to burn." Kingdom Dynamics SFLB: Seraphim are closely related to the **throne and the praises of God**. They are seen constantly glorifying God – extolling His nature and attributes, apparently supervising heaven's worship. Seraphim are seen as hovering above the **throne** as they minister in worship.

Rev 4:6-8 ... And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" This is God's authority and Sovereignty.

**Cherubim** SFLB Foot Notes: "Four living creatures are cherubim; the highest-ranking celestial beings; they represent the vital forces of creation whose primary function is worship. Full of eyes symbolizes unceasing watchfulness."

**Cherub** The cherubim were symbolical. They were intended to represent spiritual existences in immediate contact with Jehovah. Some have regarded them as symbolical of the **chief ruling power** by which God carries on his operations in providence (**Ps 18:10**) (from Easton's Bible Dictionary, PC Study Bible). Cherub are on the mercy seat of the Ark

<u>Ps 22:3-5</u> But You are holy, **Enthroned in the praises** of Israel. 4 Our fathers **trusted** in You; They **trusted**, and You delivered them. 5 They cried to You, and were delivered; They **trusted** in You, and were **not ashamed**. Our unashamed praises enthrones God over us and as we trust Him, He will deliver us!
