Fulfill all Righteousness

December 29, 2019, we started a prophetic series called "Rise of the Two Witnesses." I gave reference to the book "Numbers in the Bible" by Robert D. Johnston which stated the best understanding of the number "two" is, "fulness of testimony." This led to the understanding that 2020 is entering the time of "fulness" as to many prophetic words spoken by God's current day prophets and prophecy given in the Bible. I believe we are entering the "Fulness of Righteousness." 2 Chron 20:20 is a prophetic word that has been given for this season.

2-22-2020 Life Song Church had our first Not Ashamed Rally as we fasted and went out under the banner "Jehovah Nissi" (the Lord fights my battles), believing we were hearing prophetically from the Lord, giving great shouts of praise knowing we were entering spiritual warfare. At the rally, I made a connection with Pastor Mark Seppo from Vassar Victory Center. Then the Lord showed me there are **4 Gates in this region.** He is aligning us with these gates. The first gate is Vassar and Pastor Mark is a general in His army. God said He would not show me the next gate until after each rally. The Lord also showed me that at each of the **4 Gates** are His **Eliakim Pastors/Generals** that hold the Key of David. Eliakim means "Whom God will raise up."

Several prophetic voices have said this is a key Scripture for 2020:

<u>Isa 22:22</u> The key of the house of David I will lay on his shoulder (**Eliakim**) So he shall open, and no one shall shut; And he shall shut, and no one shall open. In <u>Rev 3:7-13</u> Jesus said these same words to the Faithful Church of Philadelphia.

The Eliakim Pastors control doors and gates. "Eliakim was elevated at the time of the Assyrian invasion as the one most adapted to meet the crisis" -Fausset's Bible Dictionary. Isaiah started prophesying about 750 B.C. The Assyrian's took Samaria (the Northern Kingdom of Israel) around 721 B.C. In 701 B.C. King Sennacherib surrounded Jerusalem and it was **Eliakim** who was sent out to talk with the representatives of King Sennacherib who mocked Judah telling them not to listen to King Hezekiah telling them that their God would save them. Eliakim was instructed to remain silent about any decision and report back to King Hezekiah. One angel of the Lord came and killed 185,000 soldiers of King Sennacherib and he returned to his land.

5-30-20 we had our **second Not Ashamed Rally** at Vassar Victory Center (1st Gate) which happened to be the eve of Pentecost and the 8 year anniversary of my miracle healing at U of M Ann Harbor. God made another alignment at the rally with Randy Williams who said we needed to bring this rally to Lapeer and through Randy and Pastor Mark, we were aligned with Pastor Tim Martin from New Life Christian Church. The **First Gate** was Vassar and the **upcoming Second Gate** is Attica. Our next Not Ashamed Rally is **8-22-2020**. Again, we did not pick this date for any particular reason. This is the one Saturday that works for all 3 churches involved.

Earlier this year I prophesied churches would be preaching on **God's righteousness** and that His righteousness is a key element to revival. While studying about water baptism, God gave me a greater revelation on righteousness which was confirmation that I needed to do a series on His righteousness. I believed God's righteousness was mostly based on His grace and mercy empowering us to do the right thing. But now I understand it is equally based on His **judgment and justice**. Along with His grace and mercy comes a godly fear of the Lord, knowing He is the Great Judge and He will pass judgment, and bring justice.

I believe the righteousness of God is being released in many different ways, but Jesus has called us, Life Song Church and those churches in the Thumb that we are forming an alliance with, to release the righteousness of God through the gate of praise and worship. Jesus said "It is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." I believe that time has come. This is especially true of the 4 Gate churches in this region.

Righteousness: Strong's #1343, *dikaiosune* (dik-ah-yos-oo-nay), just, the quality of being right. Broadly, the word suggests conformity to the revealed will of God in all respects. It is both **judicial and gracious**. W/W SFLB

The **Second Gate** Not Ashamed Rally on 8-22-2020, on the Jewish calendar is Elul 2. The Torah reading that day is Shoftim meaning "**Judges**" and is Deut 16:18 and 21:9.

So, when we have our Not Ashamed Rally on 8-22-2020, on the Jewish calendar of Elul 2, after 3 weeks of our deeper revelation of fulfilling all righteousness through not only grace but now with **justice and judgement**, at what is the #2 Gate where God told us to confirm His Eliakim Pastors, the ones who He is raising up, preparing for battle.

<u>Deut 16:18</u> "You shall **appoint judges and officers in all your gates**, which the Lord your God gives you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with **just** (righteous) **judgment**."

<u>Matt 3:13-15</u> Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. 14 And John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me?" 15 But Jesus answered and said to him, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting **for us to fulfill all righteousness**." Then he allowed Him.

After Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove descended upon Him. A dove is symbolic of gentleness, innocence and meekness and it was offered in sacrifices. When Jesus opens the Scroll in the book of Revelation, He does so as the Lion of the Tribe of Judah. The Scroll is the judgment of God that is about to be released on the earth to all people who did not receive His grace and mercy.

When Jesus came to earth the first time, it was with grace and mercy. When He comes the second time, it will be with judgment and justice as the Sword of His Word strikes the nations.

<u>2 Tim 4:7-8</u> I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Finally, there is laid up for me the **crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge**, will give to me on **that Day**, and not to me only but also to all who have **loved His appearing**.

Are you living for the Lord? Or for yourself? Do you love this world more than His appearing? What do you love more, doing His righteousness, or doing your own thing? Do you seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, or are you satisfied believing "As long as I am a good person, I am fine,"?
