Where Is Jesus Now? Seated At The Right Hand Of God, On His Throne

Mark 16:19 He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.

Luke 22:69 Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God.

Acts 2:33 Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God,

Acts 5:31 Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior,

Acts 7:55 Jesus standing at the right hand of God

Rom 8:34 at the **right hand of God**, who also makes intercession for us.

Eph 1:20 He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,

Heb 10:12 He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,

Mtt 26:64 hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power,

What Is Happening? His Enemies Are Being Put Under His Feet

Matt 22:43-44 "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"

Mark 12:36 "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

<u>Luke 20:41-44</u> 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, 43 Till I make Your enemies Your footstool

Acts 2:34-35 'The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit at My right hand, 35 Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."'

Eph 1:22 And He put all things **under His feet,** and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,

<u>1 Cor 15:24-28</u> 25 For **He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet**. 26 The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. 27 For "**He has put all things under His feet**." But when He says "**all things are put under Him**,"

When Is Jesus Coming Back? When Babylon Falls

1 Cor 15:23-28 But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. 24 Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. 25 For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. 26 The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. 27 For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under Him," it is evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted. 28 Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.

*Coming: Strong's #3952; Parousia (par-oo-see-ah), the technical term that signifies the second coming of Jesus, and it was never used to describe His first coming. It is an arrival that will include a permanent presence from that time forward. The glorified Messiah's arrival will be followed by a permanent residence with His glorified people. *WW SFLB

SFLB F/Notes 15:28: The goal of history and the consummation of the covenant will occur **when the kingdom** is delivered up to God, when creation will be completely free of all dissident, antilife forces.

<u>Matt 24:12-14</u> And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But he who endures to the end shall be saved. 14 And **this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world** as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.
