

Iran: The Prince of Persia

The **Prince of Persia** is a principality, a ruler of darkness, one with power in the spiritual-demonic realm. The Prince of Persia empowers people to carry out his will, just like other principalities in the heavenly realm. God placed “Watcher” angels over territories. Some of these Watcher angels turned against God, but not all of them. Prince Michael is loyal to Yeshua watching over Israel and God’s people.

Dan 12:1 *“At that time **Michael** shall stand up, The **great prince who stands watch** over the sons of your people; And there shall be a time of trouble, Such as never was since there was a nation, Even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, Everyone who is found written in the book.”*

Most likely, the **Prince of Persia** is a “**Watcher**” angel that rebelled against God. These entities hate God, Jews and Christians. Some of the Watcher angels left their proper domain and mated with women, creating offspring called the Nephilim; the giants. The Nephilim are considered hybrids, not fully human. It is believed the bloodline of the Nephilim are alive today.

About 400 years before Daniel was in Babylonian captivity:

God told King Saul to “utterly destroy” Amalek. God was very upset with King Saul because he disobeyed Him. God removed him from being King and had Samuel anoint David as King. This took 15 years to manifest. King Saul was from the **tribe of Benjamin**. King Agag was King of the Amalekites, they intermingled with the Horites who intermingled with giants. This contaminated the Amalekites with the **Nephilim blood line**. The giants were from the Nephilim. Amalek is another name for the Amalekites.

When Israel came out of bondage from Egypt, Amalek was the first tribe to fight against them, and they were wicked preying on the weak, elderly and the ones who were straggling behind the group.

1Sa 15:2 *Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'I will punish **Amalek** for what he did to Israel, how he ambushed him on the way when he came up from Egypt. 3 Now go and attack Amalek, and **utterly destroy** all that they have, and do not spare them. But kill both man and woman, infant and nursing child, ox and sheep, camel and donkey.' "*

1Sa 15:9 *But Saul and the people **spared Agag** and the best of the sheep, the oxen, the fatlings, the lambs, and all that was good, and were unwilling to utterly destroy them.*

God wanted the **Nephilim blood line** removed from Earth, so that is why God told King Saul to “utterly destroy” them.

Would Jesus today “utterly destroy” a blood line? Yes.

Rev 2:21 *And I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent. 22 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds. 23 **I will kill her children with death**, and all the churches shall know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each one of you according to your works.*

625 BC, Judah (Israel) had become very corrupt, just like America today. Jeremiah warned them, Babylon will come and take them captive. God has always led His people through His Prophets, His Logos and Rhema.

Jer 25:11 *And this whole land shall be a desolation and an astonishment, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon **seventy years**. 12 'Then it will come to pass, when **seventy years are completed**, that I will punish the king of Babylon and that nation, the land of the Chaldeans, for their iniquity,' says the LORD; 'and I will make it a perpetual desolation.*

Jerusalem/Judah is conquered and the Hebrews, along with Daniel are taken captive to Babylon. King Nebuchadnezzar and Babylon fell to King Cyrus. King Darius was given to be the “King in charge.” Daniel knew the Scriptures and the prophecy of Jeremiah about the 70 years of captivity, so he prayed for direction from God.

Dan 9:2 *in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the LORD through **Jeremiah the prophet**, that He would accomplish **seventy years** in the desolations of Jerusalem. 3 Then I set my face toward the Lord God to make request by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes.*

The messenger angel **Gabriel** came in response to Daniel's prayers and the prophecy of Jeremiah.

Dan 10:12-14 *Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and **I have come because of your words**. 13 But the **prince of the kingdom of Persia** withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, **Michael, one of the chief princes**, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the **kings of Persia**. 14 Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to many days yet to come."*

Gabriel asks Daniel:

Dan 10:20-21 *Then he said, "Do you know why I have come to you? And now I must return to fight with the **prince of Persia**; and when I have gone forth, indeed the **prince of Greece** will come. 21 But I will tell you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth. (No one upholds me against these, except Michael your prince).*

In fulfillment of Jeremiah's 70 year prophecy, under the edict of King Cyrus, the Hebrews were released from captivity and allowed to go back to Jerusalem, to start rebuilding their Temple. Jerusalem is about a 900-mile journey from Babylon which was in Iraq. Many of the Hebrews stayed in that area. 65 years later, in **Shushan, the Persian capital city in Iran**, **Haman** was planning on killing all of the Jews (Hebrews). This is when Queen Esther and Mordecai step in to save the Jews. The main battle took place in **Shushan, Iran**.

Haman was second in command under King Ahasuerus (Xerxes 1), the King of Persia. He ruled from Shushan. Haman hated the Jews and planned an attack to destroy them. He manipulated King Ahasuerus to give him the authority to "utterly destroy" the Jews. Queen Esther and Mordecai exposed the wickedness in Haman to the King, and the King ordered Haman and his **10 sons** to be hung. **The first thing that was taken out, was the leadership!!!**

Remember: King Saul was from the tribe of **Benjamin** and was commanded to "utterly destroy" the Amalekites, including their King Agag. Saul did not kill Agag, and the prophet Samuel had to step up and do the job, but after King Agag was allowed to live for a period of time. **Haman was a descendant of King Agag. Mordecai is from the tribe of Benjamin**, just like King Saul. **Mordecai obeyed God**, King Saul did not. God works with His Children to empower their dominion. *1-27-26 we prayed over elected officials, anointing them with the "Mordecai Anointing" to empower them.

Est 8:11-15 *By these letters the king permitted the Jews who were in every city to **gather together and protect their lives**—to destroy, kill, and annihilate all the forces of any people or province that would assault them,... And the decree was issued in **Shushan the citadel**. 15 So Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, with a great crown of gold and a garment of fine linen and purple; and the **city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad**...Then many of the people of the land **became Jews**, because fear of the Jews fell upon them.*

Est 9:26 *So they called these days **Purim**, after the name Pur. Therefore, because of all the words of this letter, what they had seen concerning this matter, and what had happened to them,*

We are in the season of Purim and a Blood Moon!

2-28-26 America (Epic Fury) and Israel (Roaring Lion) attack Iran. America strikes the nuclear facilities, missile defense, rockets, and military targets. Israel strikes the **leadership of Iran**, killing Ayatollah Ali Khamenei (spirit of Haman) and his **10 top** military leaders. King Saul Tribe of **Benjamin**, Mordecai Tribe of **Benjamin**; the name of the Israeli leader who took out the Ayatollah and 10 top military leaders? **Benjamin Netanyahu!**

Shushan is in Iran; where the main battle took place, resulting in Purim celebration. Iranians are celebrating!

Blood moons: sign of impending divine action—judgment, redemption, or the "Day of the Lord"—especially when linked to Israel's story or end-times events.

(Dan 12:1) Michael the Prince Angel has **stood up and again** defeated the **Prince of Persia** and protected Israel! Is the Day of the Lord upon us?
