Created for Good Works

Biblical World View: As the Marxist-Luciferian Deep State system gets exposed, they will shout louder, get angrier, lash out at Charismatic Christians (Zionists!), double-down on their policies, and incite more violence as they accuse the ones supporting law and order as being the ones who are lawless. They are demanding we defund the police, ICE, and Homeland Security (the law). They will fight against the SAVE Act because they need to cheat to get people elected. Review: God's grace (*charis*) and God's gifts (*charisma*) are inseparable (last weeks message).

Through God's grace comes salvation, which is a gift (*charisma*) from God that no one can take away. Included in God's grace, are His gifts to us, His children, so we can walk by faith and establish our Father's Kingdom on Earth as it is in Heaven. We cannot separate God's gifts from His grace. That would be like trying to separate His power from His Word. The two are inseparable. If we have God's grace (*charis*), we have His gifts (*charisma*). Whether we choose to receive them or not is up to us. Through God's grace, He has given us irrevocable gifts. **Rom 11:29 For the gifts (*charisma*) and the calling of God are irrevocable** (cannot be transferred, revoked, cancelled, altered, or withdrawn). Who God calls, He equips. Cessationists believe the equipping of God's gifts (*charisma*) has ceased, or has been limited. The **Cessationists** have little to no Scripture to support their claim and it **violates the continuity of Scripture**.

2025 there were **664 million Charismatic Christians** and is the fastest growing segment of Christianity. As of today 2026, it is estimated at 676 million, a 12 million increase in 6 months, with the fastest growth in South Africa, Latin America and Asia, -Grok.

Created for Good Works: The Continuity of Scripture; Jesus the Original "Charismatic!"

Through God's **grace** (*charis*) we are saved by faith, it is God's **gifts** (*charisma*) so we can **walk in Christ** doing **good works** (*ergon/energeia*) and establish His Kingdom. This is God's plan from the beginning of the world. He who begun a "**good work**" in us, will see it through to the end. He will not leave us hanging by cancelling His gifts and working power. With our great salvation comes God's grace, gifts and miracle working power to confirm His Word and do good works. **Heb 2:3-4** *how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him 4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts (*charisma*) of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?*

We are warring against the "*course of this world, the prince of power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience*". Without the gifts, grace and **working power of Jesus**, we would not have a chance! (Eph 2:2). This battle will continue until Babylon falls and Jesus returns.

Eph 2:10 *For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.*

Col 1:29 *To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.*

Works; Strong's #2041 *ergon* (er-gon), toil, energy, urge, occupation, enterprise, deed, task, accomplishment, performance, labor, course of action. Jesus used this word in **John 9:4** *"I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work."* The miraculous accomplishments and deeds of Jesus are works of God implying power and might W/W SFLB Jn 9:4

Working Strong's # 1753 *energeia* (en-erg-eye-ah); working, action, operative power. The English word "energy" comes from this word.

As followers of Christ, we have a choice: do "good works" in our own power, or in Christ's power? Some good works we can do in our own power, but Jesus has so much more for us if we believe and walk by faith, receiving His gifts (*charisma*), especially from the Holy Spirit. The works and miracles that Jesus did, was **all through the Holy Spirit**, the same Holy Spirit that empowers us with the gifts (*charisma*), empowered Jesus, the original "Charismatic!"

Joh 14:12 *"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father."*

Who the Holy Spirit “calls” for ministry, He equips. The Holy Spirit has not stopped calling us or equipping us.

Act 13:2 *As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the **Holy Spirit said**, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the **work** to which I have called them.” 3 Then, having fasted and prayed, and **laid hands on them**, they sent them away.*

The Apostle Paul commends us to “abound in the work (*ergon*) of our Lord, to be steadfast and immovable.” We cannot do this without His working power.

1Co 15:57 *But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the **work of the Lord**, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.*

Through God’s grace, we have an abundance for every good work. The continuity: grace (*charis*) empowers good works.

2Co 9:8 *And God is able to make **all grace abound** toward you, that you, **always having all sufficiency** in all things, may have an abundance for every **good work**.* We “always” will have all sufficiency, it does not cease or fade away.

Eph 4:11 *And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the **work** (*ergon*) **of ministry**, for the edifying of the body of Christ,*

God has begun a “good work” in us and will not rescind, or draw back, or cancel out anything until the day Jesus returns.

Php 1:6 *being confident of this very thing, that He who has **begun a good work in you will complete it** until the day of Jesus Christ;*

God is still strengthening us with all might and His glorious power! He is not cancelling or ceasing His gifts.

Col 1:10-11 *that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being **fruitful in every good work** and increasing in the knowledge of God; 11 **strengthened with all might**, according to **His glorious power**, for all patience and longsuffering with joy;*

2Th 1:11 *Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the **work of faith with power**,*

God’s grace establishes in us every good work.

2Th 2:16-17 *Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope **by grace**, 17 comfort your hearts and **establish you in every good word and work**.*

The Word of God equips us for every good work.

2Ti 3:16-17 *All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, **thoroughly equipped for every good work**.*

God is making us “complete in every good work” not taking something away to make us “incomplete.”

Heb 13:21 *make you **complete in every good work** to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.*

Jas 2:17 *Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have **works**, is dead...20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without **works** is dead?*

Jesus said to all 7 Churches in the book of Revelation; **“I know your works.”** This is first directed to the local church as a corporate body, and also applies to the individual. The Morning Star Authority is on the local church.

Rev 2:26-28 *And he who overcomes, and **keeps My works until the end**, to him I will give power over the nations— 27 ‘HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON; THEY SHALL BE DASHED TO PIECES LIKE THE POTTER’S VESSELS’—as I also have received from My Father; 28 and I will give him the morning star.*

Rev 22:12 *“And behold, I am coming quickly, and **My reward is with Me**, to give to every one **according to his work**.”*

The Power of God flowing through us starts with the gift (*charisma*) of salvation. Have you received this gift?
