WE DECREE!

Biblical World View: Ekklesia Prayer Coalition Simulcast from Pastor Tim Sheet's church Oasis, Friday August 14; we gathered at New Life Christian Church in Attica. Pastor Bruce Clark has an assembly at Blue Water Christian Church in Port Huron. Our battle in America against the Islamic-Socialist subversion has its spiritual roots in Iran, the Prince of Persia. Our physical war against Iran is a reflection of the spiritual war we are fighting. Through prayer, fasting, decrees, praise/worship, engaging our government and the public by exposing the evil lies and standing for the truth, we fight this battle. Over 1,000 churches from 6 continents participated along thousands of people gathered in their homes. Iran has over 5 million Christians and is the fastest growing church in the world. God said He would set His throne in two places: Jerusalem (**Jer 3:17**) and Elam (Iran), **Jer 49:38**. We released our "Declaration of God's Governing Authority" action of the Bronze Wall Alliance at this event and will do so here today.

We operate in **God's jurisdiction**; speaking, writing and releasing decrees based on His Word. We are His kings and priests, and we rule alongside of Jesus, Yeshua Hamashiach. **Rev 5:10** *"And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."* Kings have authority in the civil realm and Priests in the religious/spiritual realm.

Jurisdiction: **Juris** is Latin for "**law**" and **dictio** is Latin for "**declaration**" it is the authority given to a legal entity to enact **justice**. The power, right or authority to interpret and apply law (Meriam-Webster.com). To declare the **law** and administer **justice**. To "declare the law" is to declare the Word of God as the final authority. God gave us dominion and with dominion comes jurisdiction. As Ambassadors for Jesus Christ, we have legal grounds to stand on (Eph 6:20).

Decree typically refers to an **authoritative, binding decision or edict**—often portrayed as God's sovereign, unchangeable determination or a formal order from someone in authority (like a king or ruler). It carries the sense of something established with finality and power to enforce it. It is a command backed by the authority of Jesus Christ.

The prayer "Our Father" is actually a **prophetic decree** calling forth the Kingdom of God: *"Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven."* (**Matt 6:9,10**).

The first decree in the Bible is when God said *"Let there be light; and there was light"*

We have been **prophesying and decreeing** for several years;

"Justice will bring forth Liberty, the Supreme Law of the Land will stand and Jurisdiction will be established, making the crooked places straight." President Trump is dismantling the Deep State, but will only be successful if the Church, the Ekklesia, engages in spiritual warfare, as they step into God's governing authority (Morning Star Authority).

"Former SPLC CFO Heidi Beirich was arrested by federal officers this week on charges of wire fraud and conspiracy to submit false statements to a federally insured bank. The arrest comes as part of the U.S. Department of Justice's ongoing case regarding the **Southern Poverty Law Center's** 4.1-million-dollar scheme to defraud donors and pay the very "extremists" — including Beirich's neo-Nazi lover — the organization *claimed* to be fighting."

Luk 10:19 *Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.*

Eph 1:17 *that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.*

22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Psa 91:11-13 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. 12 In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. 13 You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, The young lion and the serpent **you shall trample underfoot.**

In the **book of Esther**, Haman hated the Jews so he had a **decree written**, signed by the King to kill the Jews. Mordecai found out, informed Queen Esther, and the King allowed them to **write their own decree** for the Jews to assemble together and fight back. The Jews defeated their enemies; Haman and his sons were hung. This is the holiday Purim.

Queen Esther had to speak out against what Haman (second in command) was planning against the Jews and it could have cost her life.

Est 4:13 And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. 14 For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have **come to the kingdom for such a time as this?**"

Est 9:2 The Jews gathered together in their cities throughout all the provinces of King Ahasuerus to lay hands on those who sought their harm. And no one could withstand them, because fear of them fell upon all people. 3 And all the officials of the provinces, the satraps, the governors, and all those doing the king's work, helped the Jews, because the fear of Mordecai fell upon them.

Mordecai sat in the king's gate and was involved in the government. God used Mordecai to help Esther become Queen (government position) to influence the king. God saved the Jews through a man and woman who got involved with the government. Are you called for such a time as this?

First we are called to give our life to Jesus Christ, then to love God, love one another and advance/build His Kingdom on Earth as it is in Heaven. Are you in?
